The north transept and crossing were started before the south, showing the transition from formal capitals to the fist sign of foliate designs.

Starting in the 1190s the nave was rebuilt in many small stages, and it would seem around an earlier structure that was left in place for many years. The clerestory and vaults were built over this in the next decade.

Eastern chapels replaced much later. Much evidence destroyed in the war.
