Auvers-sur-Oise, Notre-Dame-de-l'Assomption

The north transept would have been started before the first crusade along with the lower external walls of the choir.

Complex construction program in the choir, with only small injections of funds during the 1110s until in the 20s work was speeded up with the completion of the eastern end of the building and the transepts before the mid-30s.

The nave aisles were constructed during the 80s, apparently with a pause until work recommenced in the triforium and clerestory over the next two decades. Flyers were intended from the beginning.
